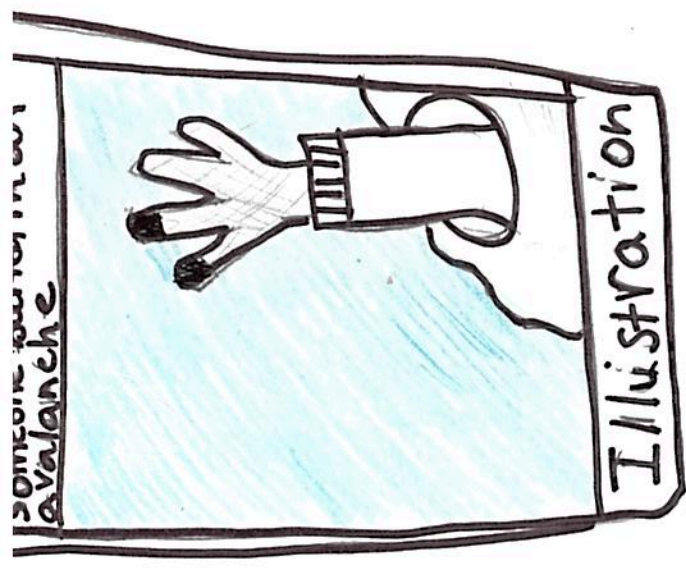

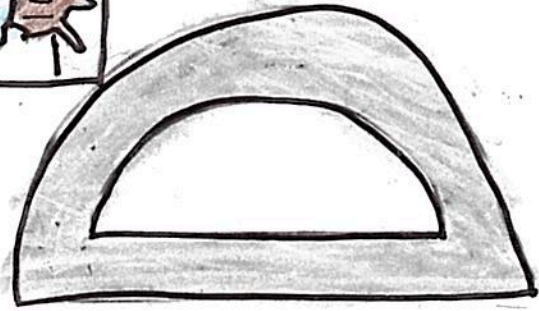

is for Destroy

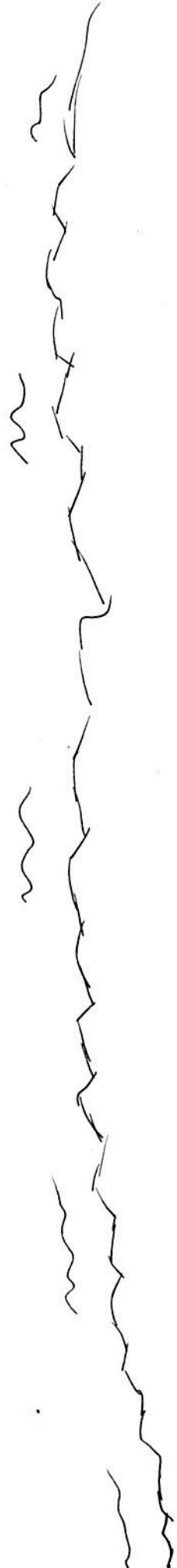


AN avalanche destroys every thing in its path, such as rocks, trees, possibly homes if they are close.

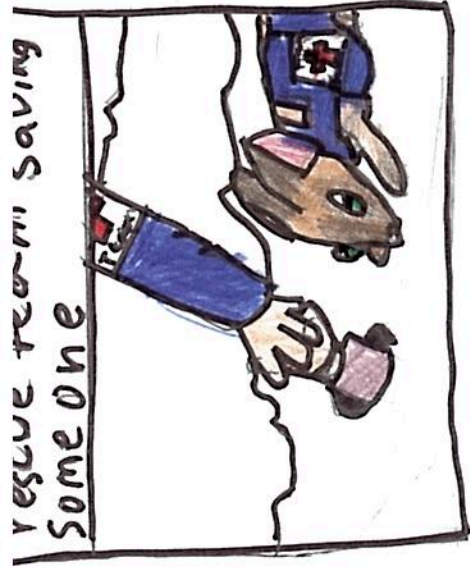

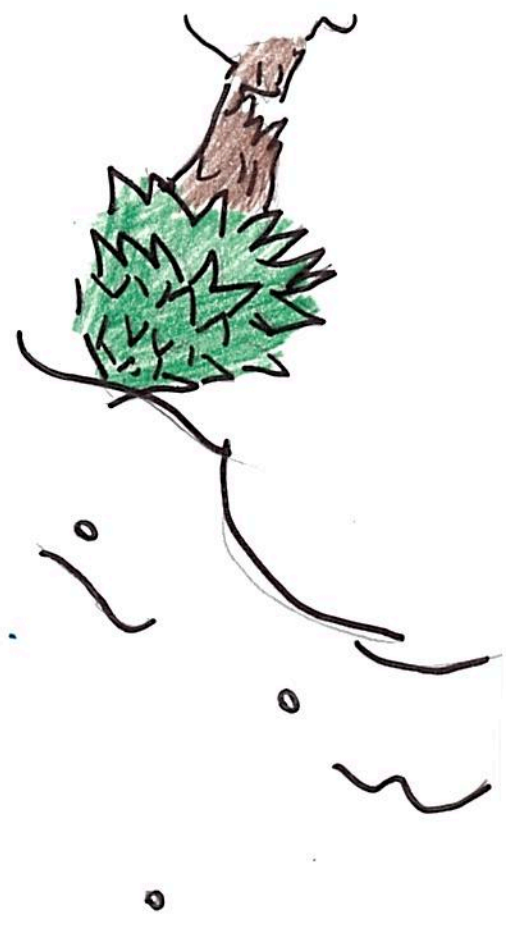

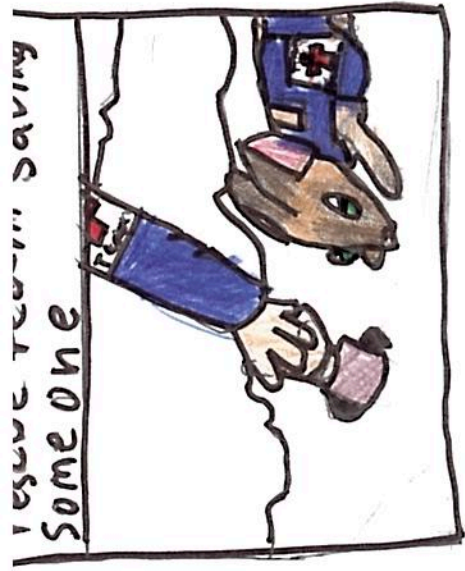

Hypothermia is a temperature in the body under 95 degrees.

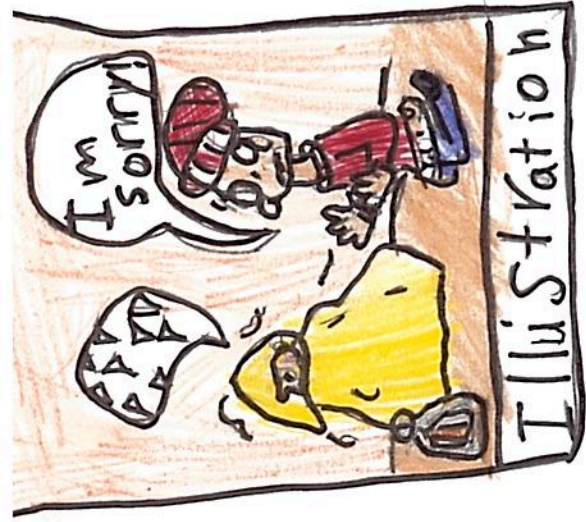
- Signs of Hypothermia

is for Ice

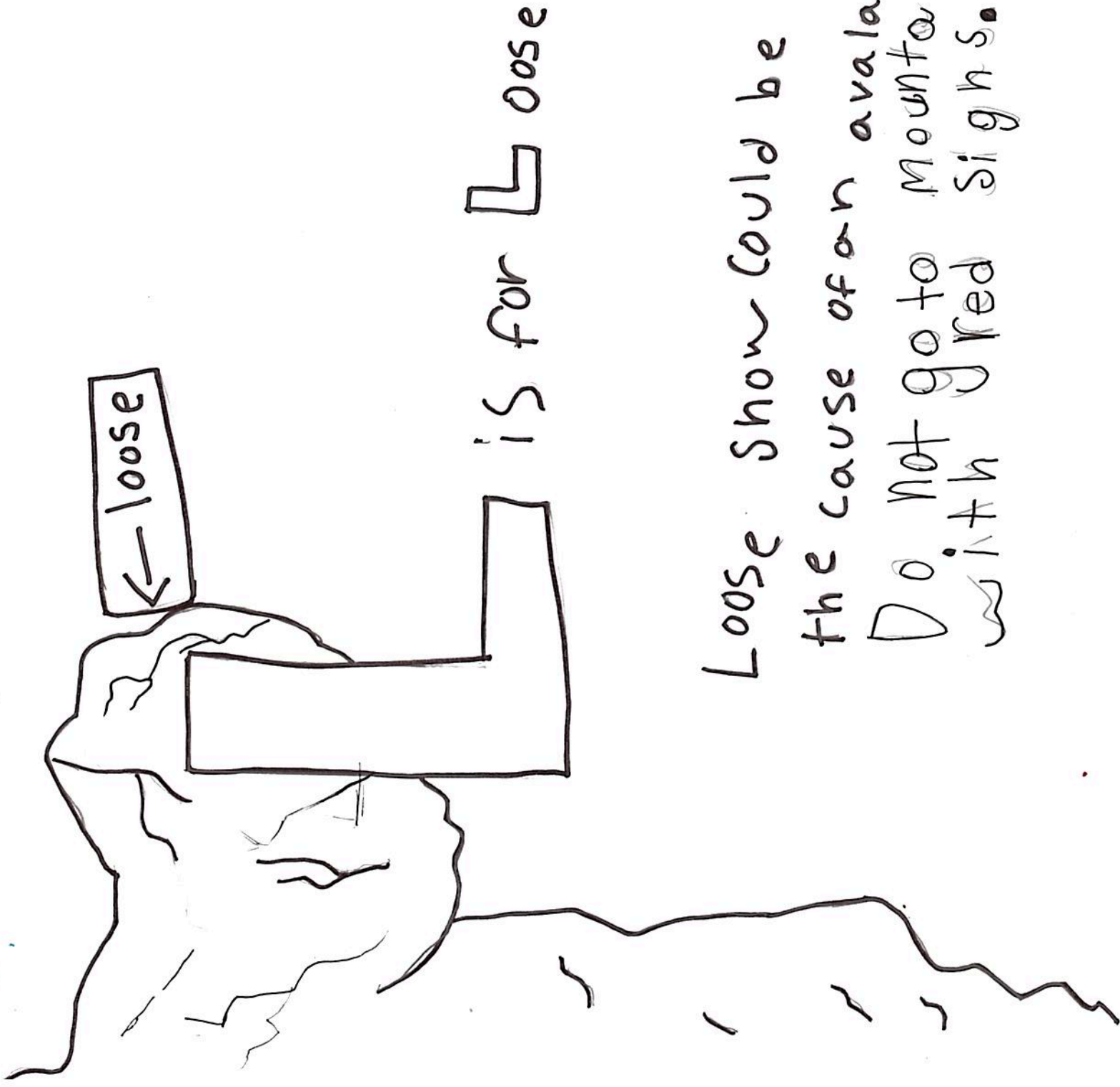
In an avalanche ice flys down

Alps — A mountain range in Europe that has the most avalanches

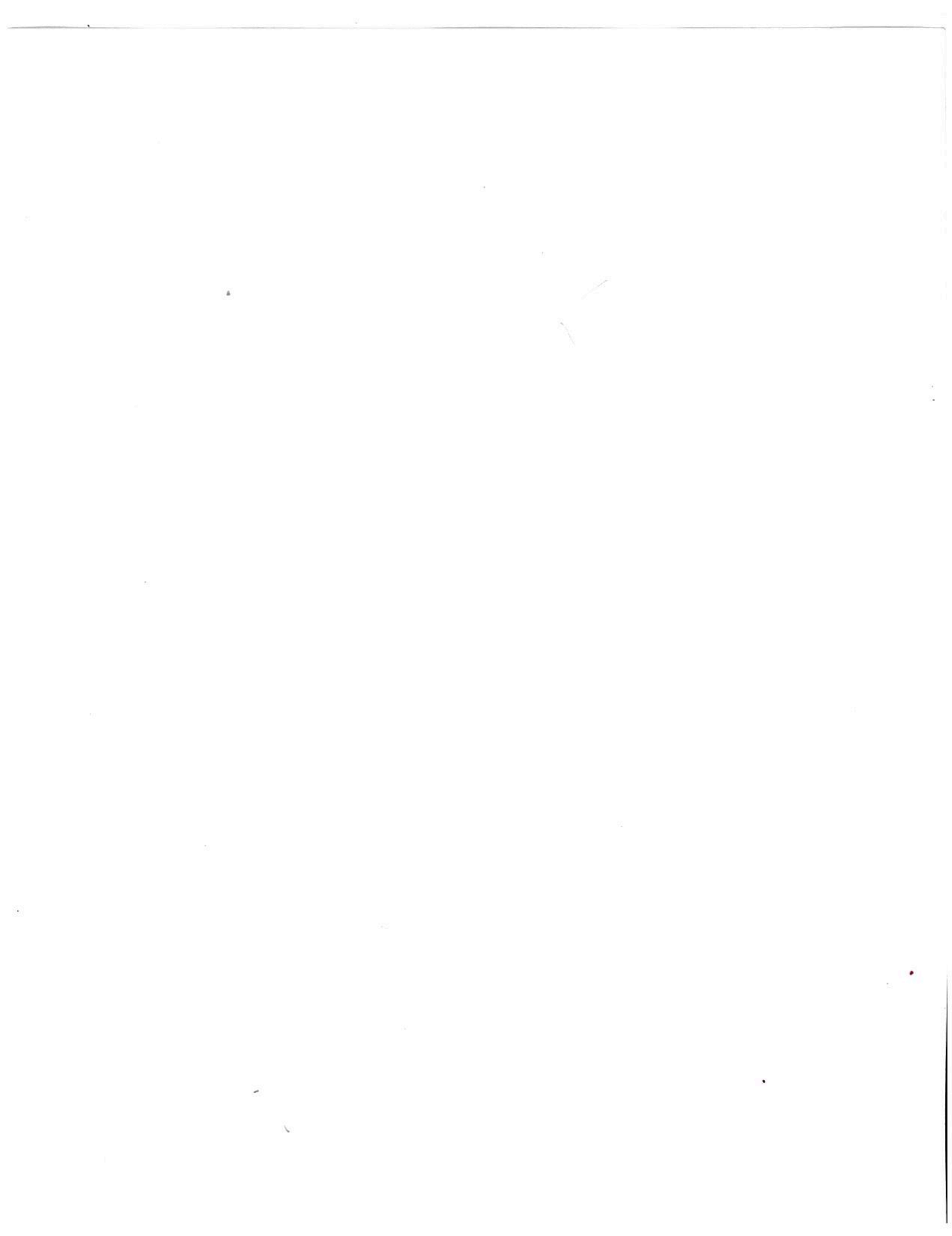
